Day 1, Berlin – Leipzig – Nuremberg

Your driver guide will take you on your onward journey today from Berlin to Nuremberg with a stop enroute in Leipzig in the province of Saxony. For centuries Nuremberg was the capital of the Holy Roman Empire of German Nation and the residence preferred by most German kings who kept their crown jewels here. Stuffed with architectural master pieces the town became very attractive for famous artists such as Albrecht Dürer who actually was born in Nuremberg. Enjoy the Old Town with splendid views of the castle. 1 night in Nuremberg.

Day 2, Nuremberg – Romantic Road – Rothenburg ob der Tauber – Heidelberg

The Romantic Road that runs from the River Main to the Alps, from the city of Würzburg to Füssen, is one of Germany's popular tourist routes. The name Romantic Road expresses what both domestic and international travellers feel on seeing Medieval towns or the fairy tale castle at Neuschwanstein: fascination and the sense of being transported back in time. Strolling about Rothenburg ob der Tauber is like a journey through a thousand years of history that seems to be passing by in the very moment! You will discover very well preserved buildings and churches, fountains, gables, bay windows and street signs from old times. In the late afternoon you will arrive at Heidelberg. The city is known world wide for its university and castle, for five hundred years the residence of the Prince Electors of the Palatinate. You will be enchanted both by its Medieval character and modern life style in the city. Heidelberg is a great place to explore the past and presence and learn about the German culture. 1 night in Heidelberg.

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Day 3, Heidelberg – Speyer – Baden Baden

After breakfast you will spend some time to explore Heidelberg. From there it's just a short drive to Speyer. The small town has a lot to offer in terms of culture: The 1000 years old Imperial Romanesque Cathedral and Memorial Church, a distinctive Jewish legacy and much more ...

After a coffee break and some time at leisure we will arrive at Baden Baden in the early evening. This spa town, along with Wiesbaden is one of the most famous and oldest in Germany, originating from the time of the Roman Emperor Caracalla. 2 nights in Baden Baden.



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Day 4, Baden Baden – Black Forest

Today you will venture out for a full-day excursion on the scenic Black Forest Highway offering us wonderful scenic impressions of "Indian summer" in this South Western part of Germany. In case of interest we can arrange for an optional wine tasting experience.





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Day 5, Baden Baden – Stuttgart – Metzingen – Munich

This morning we will continue via Stuttgart (the city is home of two brands of Germany's car industry, Porsche and Mercedes) to Metzingen. The small town is located a 2 hours drive from Baden Baden and a 2,5-hours-drive from Munich. Metzingen boasts with a great choice of designer outlet stores initiated by the German fashion designer Hugo Boss, today the top outlet shopping destination in Europe.

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
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Day 6, Munich – City orientation tour – Half day at leisure (morning or afternoon)

The annual Oktoberfest with more than six million visitors during sixteen days has turned into a global trade mark. The city is home of BMW, MAN and Siemens and many high-tech and IT-companies. And it's just a stone's throw away from the beautiful Bavarian Alpine scenery. On our city tour we will see all major sights of Munich including a stop at the BMW world and its show room.

Day 7, Chiemsee – Salzburg – Lake Tegern

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We continue our drive to Salzburg. The magnificent Baroque city is world famous for its great music tradition. Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart spent his childhood and youth there, the town seems to reverberate with his work. On our leisurely walking tour we will pass through Getreidegasse where Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart was born in 1756. After visiting a historic Mozart site you are free to enjoy a lunch break at one of the coffee houses or have lunch at one of the local restaurants.

In the late afternoon onward drive to your hotel at Rottach Egern or Tegernsee. The two villages are located on the shores of Lake Tegern 55 km South of Munich, amidst a charming scenery and surrounded by mountains – the perfect place for the start into your Bavarian honeymoon experience. Tegernsee is one of the many beautiful lakes that you will find all over Upper Bavaria. In this relaxing environment you may want to go on a boat tour, take a walk, go on an e-bike tour or enjoy the atmosphere in one of the many cozy local restaurants and cafés like the Aran coffee house situated directly on the lake. 3 nights at Lake Tegern.





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Day 9, Lake Tegern – Neuschwanstein – Oberammergau – Lake Tegern

Find out about the myth of King Ludwig II, the most enigmatic of the Bavarian Kings. Known for his affinity with extravagance and fine arts he was called “The Fairy Tale King”. Herrenchiemsee and Linderhof castles are considered as his top architectural achievements. Neuschwanstein, a two-hours-drive from Munich is the best known and, regarding its setting, most spectacular of the royal Bavarian castles. It served as inspiration for Walt Disney’s fairy tale castles. Our route will take you through the beautiful Upper Bavarian landscape offering you a great many impressions of the marvellous Alpine scenery. Following lunch continue to Oberammergau, the village famous of its Passion Play. Return to Lake Tegern in the early evening.


