



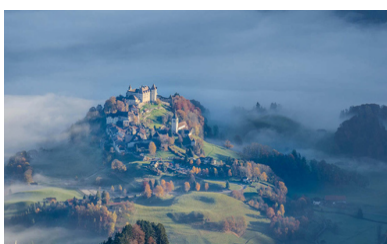

Zurich – Lucerne – Interlaken – Vevey – Geneva
8 Days/7 Nights

Day 1, Arrive in Zurich and drive to Lucern

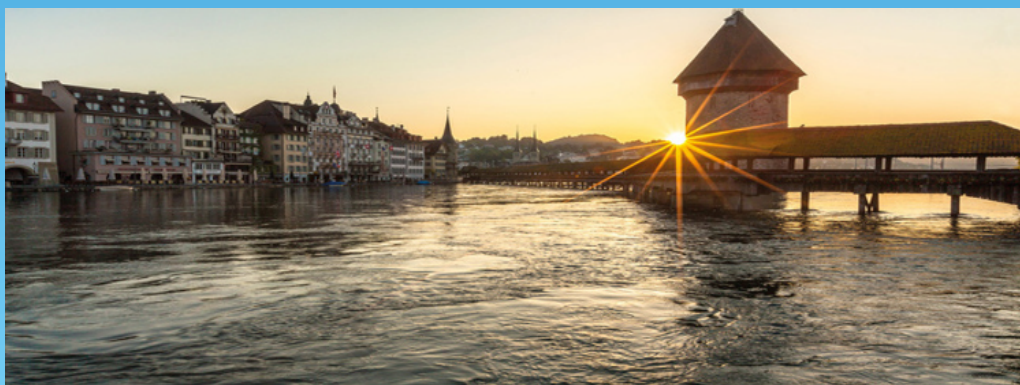
From Zurich it's only an hour's drive to Lucerne. The city with a population of about 90.000 inhabitants is located on the Vierwaldstätter See, a lake that forms the geographical heart of Switzerland. The region is historically important as it experienced the union of the first three cantons that established the origins of the Swiss democracy that exists until today.

Today evening we will visit the historical and well preserved Old Town, listed a World Heritage site, with the Chapel Bridge, the longest and one of the best preserved covered bridges in Europe.

Day 2, May 18 Lucern

Half day excursion to Mount Titlis by private car and cable car. Discover Mount Titlis' dramatic summit independently. You could explore the cultural and historical sites of Lucerne and absorb the city's charm, while going to Pilatus or on the way back as well. Travel onward to Engelberg, a resort cradled by the Swiss Alps, and then ascend to the summit of Mount Titlis for breathtaking Alpine vistas. Take a hailift to get up close to frozen crevices.

Later we will have another interesting activity like a watch making workshop etc. We will decide the exact activities shortly.

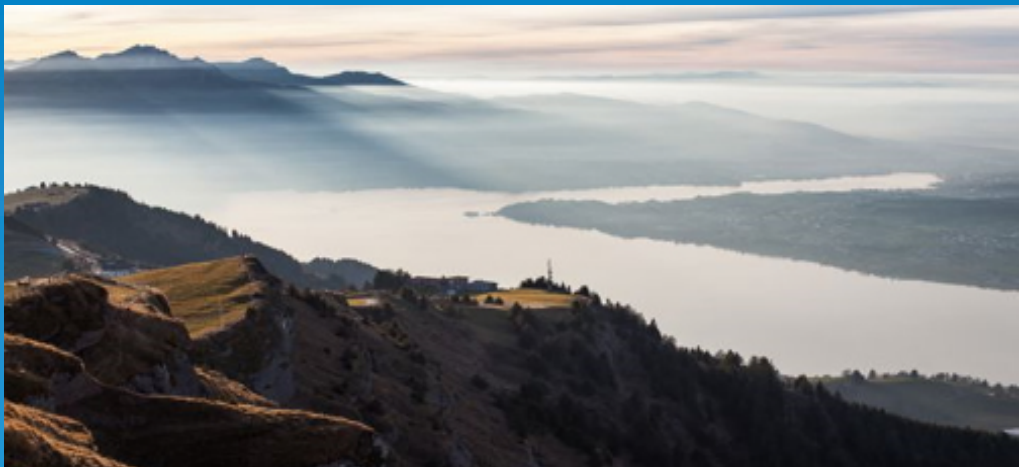


Swiss mountain world at Jungfrauoch

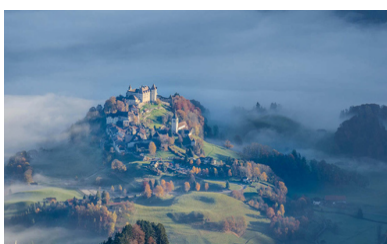

Day6, May 21 Top of Europe – Jungfrauoch – Interlaken

After an early breakfast you will depart on an excursion via Lauterbrunnen and Wengen to Kleine Scheidegg. From there you undertake a private tour by the Jungfrau Railway to the highest railway station in Europe located at 3,454 metres above sea level. This spectacular railway journey will take you through the Eiger and the Mönch to the Jungfrauoch in a mountain world of eternal ice and snow. Day 7, May 22 Interlaken – Vevey (150 km)

After an early breakfast onward drive South through the Swiss Alps to Vevey. Throughout its history, Trois Couronnes has hosted royalty, famous musicians, writers, composers and movie stars such as Tchaikovsky, Camille Saint-Saëns, Henry Miller and Sir Peter Ustinov. Its unique history and cultural richness continues to distinguish itself in the region. Through its partnerships with various events that attract worldwide attention, the hotel offers its guests entry to lively and notable experiences: The Montreux Jazz Festival, The Classical Music Festival, Musical September, and Images Festival are among some of the offerings of this region.

Day8, May 23 Vevey

Today we will do a chocolate and cheese private tour. Pick-up at your accommodation is at around 10am Your driver picks you up at your accommodation in Vevey. Private transfer to Gruyère, where the Cheese & Chocolate experience will start. First you visit the Maison du Gruyère where the mysteries of the production of this famous Swiss cheese will be revealed to you. After this, you visit the charming medieval town of Gruyères & the its magnificent castle. Finally, you reach the legendary Maison Cailler in Broc. There, you will discover the secrets of the creation of Swiss chocolate and participate in high flavoured tasting sessions. Private transfer back to Vevey.
